Where to find your favourites

Members' Lounge > Member-Only Content

We've changed the members' lounge from a single section on the site to member-only content on the whole site. All you have to do is register (see inset) and you can view the content that is available exclusively to you as a NAVA member.

Practical Advice/Fees and Wages/Code of Practice > Advice Centre

All the information you used to find in Practical Advice is now in the Advice Centre. Information on Tax, Marketing, Copyright, Fees and Wages and the Code of Practice are all in the Advice Centre.

NAVA Grants > Grants & Prizes

Information, guidelines and forms for all NAVA's grant programs are available here, as well as member-only information on other current grants, prizes, awards & residencies.

Notices of exhibitions > Notice Board

You can upload information and images about any upcoming events onto the new Notice Board, a calendar of visual arts events around the country.

Art Sector Guide/Services Directory > Links & Services

Here you can browse or search the useful links NAVA has selected as well as the Services Directory, which is a searchable directory of business and services, all of which are helpful to artists. You can also check for NAVA member discount and add new services to the directory.

Artists Listings/Upload an Image > Artist Gallery

The Artist Gallery is now bigger and better. You can upload to your Artist Profile up to 10 images, an artist's statement, a link to your website and allow people to contact you via email using a confidential contact form. You can also search the gallery for an artist or artform you are particularly interested in. To set up your Artist Profile first register and login, then go to Artist Gallery>edit my profile: here you can add details such as your artforms, artist statement and url, and choose whether you wish to make your address public. To upload images to your profile go to Artist Gallery>upload image, you will need to click on the image, and then the 'edit' tab in order to change the details of any images you have entered.

News & Views > News Desk/Media Desk

This section has the latest visual arts news: who won prizes; what policies affect you and what's going on in the arts. With an RSS feed, you can keep your site up to date and the Media Desk gives you access to the latest NAVA media releases.

Brand new features:

Register

Current NAVA Members: Click on 'Register', then on the 'Request New Password' tab. Do not enter a Username. Enter the email address your e-bulletin goes to and a link will be sent to you allowing you to log in. You will then be able to set your own password.

Non NAVA Members: You are welcome to create a User Account and interact with the site. You will be able to load notices, create an artists' profile and access the majority of content but will not be able to view member only content.

Click on 'Register', Enter a Username, email address and password then select 'Create New Account'. You will need to click on a link in the validating email to get full access.

Once signed in, you can view/edit your user account details. Your details are protected by encryption security but you must keep your password secure so that others cannot have access to your account details.
